The Idea:

Execution strategy:

An advertisement for the event has been communicated to the Journalism and mass communication departments of Delhi NCR based colleges/ institutes for more participation of the students. The principals/ heads of the colleges/ institution have been requested to put up the advertisements on the notice boards of their respective colleges/ institutes for more participation.

Terms and conditions:

- The competition is open for the students of Journalism, mass communication and all Unani colleges.
- Competition will be closed on 31st January, 2019 at 17:00 hrs
- To enter the competition, please submit a write up 600 to 1000 words on "Mainstreaming Unani Medicine in Public Health" by email only to ccrum.socialmedia@gmail.com
- Only one entry per person is allowed. More than one entry from one entrant will lead to disqualification. Entries will not be accepted in bulk or on behalf of someone else. Joint submissions will not be accepted.
- Only typed text will be accepted in double space 12 point font size, Time New Roman font in MS Word.doc. or docx file format., Margins of 2.54 cm on top, bottom and both sides.

- Cover of the written submissions: It should include name of the Participant, Address, E-mail ID, Contact Number, Name of the College/University with address and email id.
- Page numbering of the written submissions: Written submissions shall be page numbered consecutively in Arabic numbers (i.e.1, 2, 3 etc.). Such numbering may be in the main text or in the footer/header.
- Only original unpublished articles in English on the above theme in the given format would be considered.
- Plagiarism will result in immediate disqualification.
- By submitting your entry for this competition, you agree and warrant that (a) your entry has not been published before (b) your entry is entirely your own original work, and (c) nothing in your entry is defamatory, private or an infringement of copyright or other intellectual property right or in any way a breach of another's rights
- The organizers shall not be responsible for contracting or forwarding prizes to entrants who provide unclear or incomplete information or for entries lost, misdirected, delayed or destroyed.
- Any entry in breach of this clause will be disqualified from participating in and winning the competition.
- Winner will be selected from the entries received in accordance with these terms and conditions based on the following criteria: writing skills, originality, creativity, relevance to the theme, and utility value of the write-up for the general public.
- The Editorial committee of the competition will read and shortlist the entries received in accordance with these terms.
- Winner will be announced on the website of CCRUM i.e. ccrum.res.in or and conference website www. ayush-unaniday.in
- All entries retain copyright on their entry. However, the entrants grant the
 organizers a non-exclusive license to publish their entry, in whole or in part, in print
 or online.
- The organizers reserve the right to alter the prizes, terms and conditions or cancel
 the competition. No alternatives to prizes will be given. If the entries are not of
 sufficiently high quality the organizers may extend the closing date (in which case
 it may also be necessary to alter the prize). Entries will not be returned.
- All disputes pertaining to writing competition, 2019 shall fall within the jurisdiction of Delhi only.
